Dear parents and carers,

The new landscaping and play equipment near the hall is almost complete. It was a very expensive joint venture by the P&C and the school. Unfortunately we have already had damage occur. The extremely expensive soft fall was poured on Monday and the area was fenced and taped. During Monday afternoon a large foot sized person has run across the setting soft fall and we have permanent footprints in it. The cost of replacing this is too high to consider so this careless act will stay with us forever. If you have further information it would be gratefully and discreetly received.

Stage 3 students are going on their **Canberra Camp** next week. Students will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$20 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.



There will be a focus on a few different premises of historical interest. Bondi Public School, Bondi Post Office, Bondi School of Arts, shops


