Education Week is a celebration of NSW public education and runs from Monday 5 August to Friday 9 August. The theme for this year is *'Every Student, Every Voice'*. It is a celebration of student empowerment and how the NSW public education system gives students the skills they need in order to have and express a voice during their own education journey and as engaged global citizens.

We have a number of events being held during Education Week that I would like to invite you to. We have the official launch of our Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) Program on Monday 5th August. There will be a parent workshop at 8.00 in the library followed by a whole school assembly in the hall. Grandparents Day/Open Day is on Friday 9th August. There will be a special assembly at 9.15am followed by open classrooms at 9.45am. Morning Tea will be provided for all of our visitors after the open classrooms down near the hall.

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I'm sure she will be welcomed warmly by our community. **Miss Brown** will be covering 5P from the 5th-30th August as **Miss Pedron** has been offered the position of Relieving Assistant Principal PBL. This is a wonderful opportunity for her and it reflects her outstanding contribution to education. We wish her well and look forward to her return.

There have been significant changes to the way in which the **UNSW International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS)** Assessments are implemented and as a result we are unable to offer the full suite of assessments as we have done previously. This year we will be offering the English and Mathematics assessments only and the entire process will be reviewed at the end of the year. There will be an online enrolment process and a link will be sent out later today via dojo. The link closes on the 31st of July so please make sure you enrol this week if you are interested.

The department requires that we notify our community when we **reschedule the Staff Development Days (SDD)** that take place on the last two days of the year. All staff will be involved in four professional learning sessions outside of school hours that cover the following topics:

- School excellence and the External Validation Process
- Using Data with Confidence
- Flexible Learning Spaces

The last day of school for 2019 will be Wednesday 18th December 2019. The school will be non-operational after this date.

Our **Road Safety committee** has been working hard over the last term. They have recently made contact with the local council, who will be coming out to assess the roads surrounding our school with the aim of making them safer for our students. ROAD SAFETY INFORMATION

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY WHEN THEY ARE TRAVELLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL.

Drive and park safely near schools

The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for pedestrians and drivers outside schools.

You can help keep children safe by remembering the following:

- drop off and pick up children on the school side of the road
- never call out to children from across the road it is very dangerous
- always take extra care when driving in 40km school zones
- follow all parking signs these help keep children as safe as possible
- park responsibly even if this means you have to walk further to the school gate
- never double park it is illegal and puts children at risk
- never do a U-turn or three-point turn outside the school as it puts children at risk of harm
- model safe and considerate pedestrian and driver behaviours to your children.

When travelling in a car ensure your children:

- use a booster seat if they are aged between 4 and 7 years old – it's the law
- are correctly buckled up in their seatbelts
- always get in and out of the car through the 'safety door' – the rear door on the footpath side of the car
- are never left alone in the car.


