Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back to the 2023 school year. Students have settled quickly into their classes and the learning has already begun. Our students continue to demonstrate our school expectations of being safe, respectful learners. We warmly welcomed our Kindergarten students into their new classes this week and their Year 4 buddies look forward to helping them around the school. Thank you for your attendance at our Meet the Teacher evening sessions. Our teachers have been collaboratively planning in their Stage teams to deliver engaging lessons for our students. The NSW curriculum covers Stage based learning:

Early Stage 1 - Kindergarten Stage 1 - Years 1 & 2 Stage 2 - Years 3 & 4 Stage 3 - Years 5 & 6

The curriculum is delivered to a stage rather than a grade. Teachers then differentiate their lessons to address the individual learning needs within the classroom. This ensures that students remain challenged and engaged in lessons.



#### NAPLAN

Every year the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) assesses the literacy and numeracy skills of students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. NAPLAN tests complement the wide range of formal and informal assessments already conducted in schools. The NAPLAN testing window for students in Year 3 and 5 is from 15th March to 27th March 2023.

#### **Communicating with Teachers**

A classroom teacher's priority is to be present while teaching students in class. If the query is complex, the teacher will give you a call or request a meeting. Please note, emails are not checked or responded to during school hours (they will be addressed within 48 hours). Please ensure your child knows their pick-up arrangements for each day and contact the office in the event of an unforeseen change in plans. This should not be a regular occurrence. Please email the office at bondi-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au to inform them about your child's absence on a particular day. The message function on Dojo is not being utilised. ### **School Uniform & Uniform Recycling**

We have certainly seen an improvement in uniform consistency this term and the new uniform items look fantastic. 
