

Despite the relative affordability of these fees the school now struggles to provide these services as we have so many outstanding invoices.

We would really like to continue providing the extra programs which enrich student learning. I urge families with outstanding invoices to pay them. If you are experiencing hardship please make an appointment to see me and you can start a payment plan. Thank you to those families who have made an effort to pay after being contacted this week.

The Wellington St pick up and drop off zone runs fairly smoothly most of the time. Parked cars ruin the whole system of course but if everyone treats the zone like a taxi queue then it works well. Please don't cut into the queue because someone is taking too long or you see a gap. It really does spoil the system and adds to the confusion. The system was created to assist parents and create a safer zone for children before and after school.
